Why would you care about different box sizes??

Bees have been traditionally kept, over the years, in two deep brood boxes. The problem with this is often someone has weight lifting restrictions. One of these deep boxes filled with honey can easily weigh 100 lbs or more.

The first way to reduce this weight would be to use medium boxes for the brood chamber. An even more aggressive weight reduction would be to also go to 8-frame deep or medium brood boxes.

Good, solid-commercial, quality woodenwares. The most important thing to point out is that our assembled woodenwares are **hand built, primed and painted with care at Turtlebee Farms**. All boxes are pre-milled and drilled with finger joints and the thickest materials used in the beekeeping industry for box durability & square precision. Our frames consist of a full ½" bottom bar. Our top bars have additional horizontal fasteners so that they will never pull straight off.

All foundation has been imprinted with the hexagon and lightly sprayed with beeswax to encourage quick comb building by the bees.

Did you Know???? Approximately one third of all the food Americans eat is directly or indirectly derived from honey bee pollination. Some of the crops pollinated are cucumbers, almonds, melons, apricots, cherries, pears, apples, plums, seed alfalfa, cantaloupe, seed onions, avocados, kiwi, blueberries, cranberries, etc. Many fruits require at least 6 'hits' from a pollinating insect before fruit is set. ***A good rule of thumb is one hive per acre for ground crops; two hives per acre for fruit bearing trees.*** Honeybees are your best ally; know what you are spraying and when you are spraying it so that only your target pest is eliminated.

PACKAGE BEES are usually installed in the hive in the April/May time frame. They are brought in from the south and also the west coast because package bees and queens cannot be produced in early spring in Michigan. By the end of April or beginning of May, sometimes we can begin producing packages from our overwintered bees.

Bees are not like plant material that can experience shock. With bees, the most important thing is the quality of queens and how the beekeeper introduces them to their new hive.

Italian queens brood up earlier in the spring and maintain brood later in the fall. An extra bonus is that they produce a gentle bee. It is a misnomer for one to think they have to have a 'mean' bee to produce honey. The same bees that we sell are the ones that we also use. We find that they do quite well.

NUCS are usually mature enough to travel by the later part of May. A standard nucleus is produced on 5- 6 1/4" frames for medium boxes or 4- 9 1/4" frames for deep boxes.

We can produce nuclei on our equipment or yours for the same cost. Our recommendation is on our brand new frames and foundation. This will yield the customer the best product that we can produce.

It is our sincerest desire that you become a successful keeper of bees. Therefore, as time permits, we also offer phone and email support to our customers.

BEEKEEPING CLASSES

Hello! We are **Turtlebee Farms LLC**, also known as Timothy and Kathie Bennett. We are a home educating family located north of Howell on 30 acres of rolling woods and wildflowers, surrounded by lovely wetlands, and farming countryside.

An adventure awaits you, whether you are interested in how honey is made, the prospects of owning your own hive, or conquering your fear of stinging insects. These are just a few of the accomplishments of our two-session classes. There is something of interest for everyone and the classes are appropriate for all ages. We highly encourage family participation.

Both sessions are also for those who already own their own bees but have never really understood how to manage them. They are also designed for those who have already purchased a hive from us or have a deposit down on one. Beehives can be moved almost any time of year. But prior to June is certainly the best time. We can also schedule some advanced training at your location with those who will be specifically working with your honeybees.

In our classes we follow the life cycle of the honeybee beginning in early spring and concluding in late summer. Please allow us to take you through a summary of these sessions.

In the Spring Session (June) we will meet together for approximately five hours. We will cover **History**: How did we get to this point of honeybee management?

Math?? Yes, Math! Creation is literally supported by mathematical equations, and our honey bee (*Apis mellifera*) is no exception to this fact. **Science**: Lots of it as we go along.

If we build it will they come?

Construction & Nomenclature:

- 1) Parts for our beehive
- 2) Tools to manage our beehive

Ah! Let's take a break and enjoy our picnic lunch before we move on.

As the sun shines on our efforts, we will move into installing approximately 30,000 bees into these two different hives. No need to worry though, we have plenty of hats and veils along with full-length bee suits.

To be quite honest though, our class participants are confident enough by this time that most decline the "donning" of bee apparel.

We will have a large set of real life study prints; gaining for us an understanding of the **biology** of the honey bee. Can you name the three casts of honeybees in the hive? How about the different stages of development? These are just a few more of the things that we will be learning in our class.

***In our Harvest Session, (August)** we will begin with a hearty round of discussion about the honey bee & her keeper over the last couple of months. We'll proceed to successfully walk through all the steps of how to convince the honey bees that their "rent" is due. ☺ Everyone will have an opportunity to wrap a candle and take home a honey bear. Also, we will have a display of our complete selection of products from the beehive for those who would like to shop.

Before leaving each class, everyone will enjoy a "**taste-treat**" made with honey and receive the recipe along with class worksheets.
